Pioneer's new CLD-V2800 A slim line player that blends professional performance with style

Introducing the CLD-V2800. Pioneer's newest LaserDisc player. Just like its predecessors, it is designed for reliable use in demanding professional fields where videobased instruction and communications have become indispensable. The CLD-V2800 has virtually all the features you've come to expect of a Pioneer player, including full LD, audio CD and CDV compatibility, and a choice of remote control, barcode or computer-controlled operation. In addition, this new model incorporates such features as separate CD and LD trays, instant disc type recognition and a volume control-equipped headphone jack. And unbelievably, all this performance has been shrunk down into a lightweight 12 lbs. 9 oz. package with a compact 12-5/8" (W) X 15-11/16" (D) footprint.

RS-232C Interface and Standard Command Protocol Enable Versatile Computer Control

Pioneer has equipped the CLD-V2800 with an RS-232C interface that allows you to connect the player to most PC brands including Macintosh and Amiga. What's more, the new model responds to Pioneer's LaserDisc command protocol which is supported by dozens of multimedia authoring systems. So it's compatible with most current multimedia software and also runs programs developed for the CLD-V2400, CLD-V2600, LD-V2200 and LD-V4400 with little or no modification.

Pioneer's LaserBarcode System Takes the Trial and Error out of Using the Remote Control

Designed to simplify remote control operation, the CLD-V2800's LaserBarcode system conforms with the latest industry standards. The operator simply scans a printed barcode from the support materials provided with the relevant software package using an optional handheld barcode reader, and the CLD-V2800 executes the playback commands encoded within that barcode. The system is so easy to use that literally anyone can initiate complex operations after just a few minutes of instruction. In addition, barcode creation software such as Bar 'n' Coder[™], BarKoder[™] for Windows and LaserDisc Controller are available to allow you to generate your own barcodes in order to integrate existing resource materials with videodiscbased presentations.

Bar Code CD[™] Permits Versatile CD Audio Playback

In addition to its impressive video and multimedia capabilities, the CLD-V2800 plays conventional audio CDs while providing much more flexibility than a regular CD player. The Bar Code CD™ system allows access to any point on the disc for instant playback of any desired music or language selection, as well as permitting computer-controlled playback and enabling the preparation of innovative interactive audio applications. Operating under Bar Code CD^{TM} or under computer control, the CLD-V2800 is capable of locating and playing audio segments just a fraction of a second in length-small enough to pinpoint a single word, a syllable or a musical note.

Direct CD Trav

Besides a full-size LD tray, the CLD-V2800 incorporates a separate tray that accepts CDs and CD singles. Designed for more convenient operation, this tray offers smooth one-touch play-





Two-Way Disc Tray opening: Full size tray for LDs and small size tray for CDs.




The CLD-V2800 is capable of playing both 12" and 8" LDs and is also fully compatible with standard 5" standard audio CDs, 3" CD singles and 5" CDV (Compact Disc Video) discs.


Superb Audio and Video Fidelity

Pioneer's LaserDisc optical system utilizes a non-contact laser pickup to ensure clear, high resolution video reproduction that doesn't deteriorate over time. Moreover, the CLD-V2800's superb picture quality is matched by advanced audio circuitry that delivers extremely high-fidelity sound with a 98 dB signal-tonoise ratio. And to add to its application possibilities, this model can reproduce two digital and two analog audio channels, plus two video outputs to simplify video monitor connection.

Optional RF Modulator
The CLD-V2800 can be fitted with an optional RF modulator to allow connection with a television set or video monitor via the latter's antenna terminal in cases where regular AV terminals are not available.







Auto Start and Auto Repeat

If a disc is inserted and the player is in the Power On mode, playback begins automatically when the main power is switched on. The player can also be set to repeat continuously until playback is stopped manually, either by remote control or via the main power switch. These functions make the CLD-V2800 perfect for exhibition and in-store display applications, as playback can begin and end automatically when the room's power is turned on and off.

Large Size Remote Control Unit

The ČLD-V2800's wireless infrared remote control unit features extra-large keys to allow easier and more convenient operation during lectures, presentations, etc.

Text Display for Titles, Instructions and Comments

Pioneer has provided the CLD-V2800 with a handy text display function that allows alphanumeric displays of up to 10 lines x 20 characters (upper or lower case) to be superimposed over any on-screen image.

Reinforced Chassis and Grounded Power Cord

Despite its diminutive dimensions, the CLD-V2800 employs a specially designed reinforced chassis which is strong enough to support a weight of 20 lbs. (9.1kg). In addition, this model is equipped with a three-prong grounded power cord to ensure maximum safety.

Headphone Jack with Volume Control

Featuring a handy volume control, this headphone jack is ideal for library or media center use, individual lessons and other situation where private listening is desired.

ront Panel Display

The CLD-V2800 is equipped with a bright fluorescent display that enables easy viewing of the player's current status.
